- 1. JROTC is an elective class for leadership, citizenship, academic achievement and developing personal responsibility. Successful cadets can take up to 4 years of JROTC.
- 2. JROTC combines academic, physical, social and leadership opportunities. All cadets will have the opportunity to attend competitions, Color Guards, community service and school support activities.
- 3. JROTC expects our cadets to be focused and involved in all school activities. Cadets are encouraged to participate in all academic, social and sports available at Pahrump Valley High School.
- 4. JROTC is not a military recruitment program. Very few cadets enter military service. We will introduce you to the service branches and you will have presentations from service recruiters. Anyone who is interested in the military must meet rigid requirements to include passing the ASVAB, being physically fit and completing a background check.
- 5. Normally, cadets wear a military dress uniform one designated day per week. This is mandatory and there are grooming standards which will be taught. Uniforms are provided by the U.S. Army but cadets and parents are responsible for them and will sign a hand receipt to ensure safe return.
- 6. Cadets are responsible to maintain contact with both the JROTC Instructors and their classroom teachers throughout the school year. Covid-19 revealed an almost total breakdown in communication and self discipline during the quarantine period.
